#### Adventure in Relationship - Beacon Interfaith Housing Collaborative

Through our relationship with the Beacon Collaborative, CTK continues to support families experienceing homelessness and housing instability. Here's how we help... Vista 44 is 50 new high-quality affordable housing apartments for families, that began welcoming families last July. One, two and three-bedroom apartments for families who make less than \$30,000 a year. And it's not just *any* affordable housing, but *supportive* affordable housing. Individualized on-site support services help children do better in school, parents increase income, and families improve long-term health. To help families sustain long-term stability, congregations are given the opportunity to donate items that are hard for the families afford. The CTK Housing for All campaign team is proposing a semi-annual supply drive to help ease the financial burden for the families at Vista 44. For the next month, we will be collecting: **paper products, personal hygiene items, kid's community room items**. (See specifics in the commons.)
